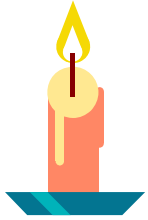

Diocesan Lenten Regulations

“Whoever wishes to be my follower must deny his very self, take up his cross each day, and follow in my steps” (Lk 9:23). The Church has always helped us fulfill these words of Jesus by prescribing very definite penance for all Catholics. Accordingly, the Pope, the Patriarch and the American bishops have outlined obligatory fast and abstinence as follow:

* **Ash Monday (February 15th) and Good Friday (April 2nd)** are days of *abstinence* for all Catholics *over the age of 14*. On these two days, *fast* as well as abstinence is also obligatory for those *from the ages of 18-59*. Abstinence means abstinence from meat. Fast means no food from midnight to noon. No Catholic will lightly excuse himself or herself from this obligation.

* **All other Fridays of Lent** are days of *abstinence* from meat. Here again Catholics will not hold themselves lightly excused, but if there is a serious health problem, this obligation would not apply.

* We strive to make all days of Lent a time of prayer and penance. In Eastern Catholic traditions, including the Maronite tradition, there is **no fast on Saturday and Sunday**, days that celebrate Creation and Resurrection.

Lenten Fridays

Every Friday of Lent (except for Holy Friday), the Maronite Church celebrates the service of the **Benediction of the Cross**. The “Stations of the Cross”, which come from a Roman tradition, are very fervent prayers and we encourage you to keep praying them at home, with your family. The “Benediction of the Cross” is a very ancient Maronite tradition that we celebrate every Friday at Holy Family at **6:30 pm**. Please join us in worship.

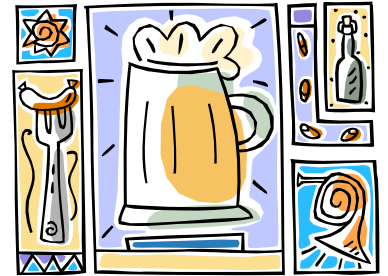

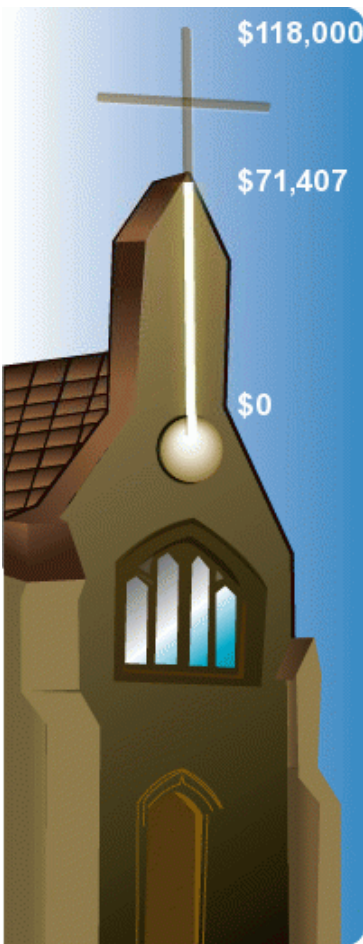
Capital Campaign Update
