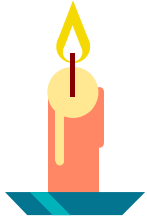

Investment Opportunity

The stewardship committee is moving forward with a plan to create a group of investors that would carry the current Holy Family Church mortgage of approximately \$750,000. This group would hold a seven year contract for deed at a rate of 5% paid annually. The minimum investment would be \$50,000. Although this is a large investment, interested parishioners could secure a home equity loan from Wells Fargo or US Bank at a rate of 4.00 - 4.25% and earn 5%. Other parishioners may have CDs earning far less, that could be converted to this investment and earn a much better rate of return. This investment will not be FDIC insured but will be backed by the church property including the rectory. The most recent appraisal has valued these properties at 1.8 million. If the mortgage is converted, Holy Family will save \$160,000 over the next seven years and investors will earn a very attractive rate of return.

Several questions were raised at the April 11th breakfast concerning this investment and what it means to become an investor.

Question: When does the investor need to produce the \$50,000?

Answer: **The money must be paid up front**, and in full. The intent of this group of investors is to purchase the mortgage. That means all the money must be paid up front in order to purchase the mortgage from the current lender. This new lending group will reduce the amount of interest that the HFC will pay. This reduces the overall amount HFC will pay for the loan including interest. HFC will save money in interest over the next 7 years. In addition, the interest charged by this new lending group will be a simple interest and not compounded monthly which will also save the church a large amount of money.

Question: When will the investors see a return on their money?

Answer: After the first year, investors will begin to see a return on the money loaned AND interest. Investors will be paid each year, for seven years, till the loan is paid up. The payments made by the Church will go towards paying down the principle as well as providing the lenders with interest.

Question: What if at some point during these 7 years, I need to pull out my investment?

Answer: This is a commitment for 7 years. You do, however, have the right to sell your portion of the investment. You can sell it to other members of the group or to someone outside the group but it is your responsibility to find someone to buy your share.

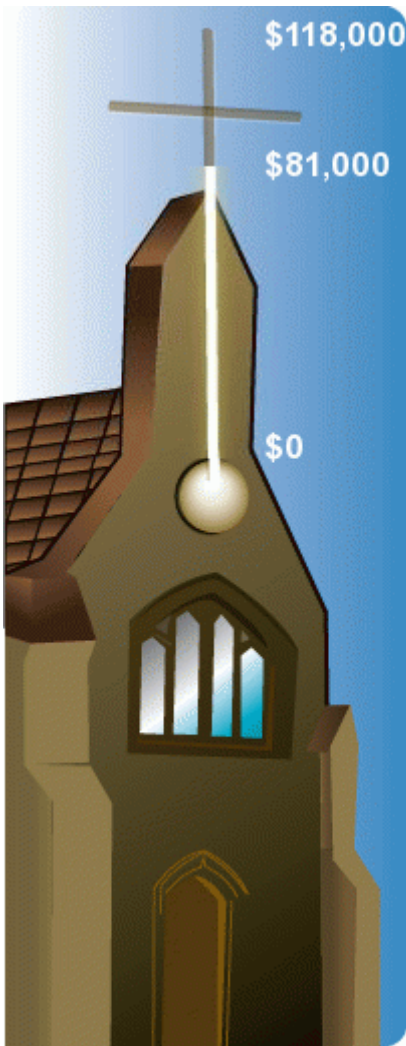

This is a good opportunity for investment and it is very good for the church.
